Hagåtña, Guam – Bank of Guam announces record-breaking milestones following their Hagåtña City Run and Block Party held on March 9, 2024.

The signature event, now in its 17th year, raised nearly \$87,000 through sponsorships, race registration, vendor pledges, beer garden and merchandise sales, and team registration from the Clutch 3x3 Basketball Tournament – all of which reported its biggest number in years.

A check for one hundred percent of all cash donations and proceeds totaling \$79,635, was presented to the event's two beneficiaries, the Guam Chapter of the American Cancer Society and Guam Cancer Care, at the Bank's recent quarterly celebration in front of over 300 Bank of Guam employees.

- A total of 42 of the fastest finishers were recognized in their respective age divisions with Hugh Kent finishing first overall, Derek Mandell finishing second, and Ryan Matienzo finishing third

- A total of 27 teams participated in the Clutch 3x3 Basketball Tournament featuring some of Guam's best boys and girls middle school players
