UPDATED: BANK OF GUAM ANNOUNCES TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GUAM AND CNMI BRANCHES DUE TO TROPICAL STORM BOLAVEN

5:15 AM (ChST) Hagåtña, Guam – Bank of Guam announced today the temporary closure of its branches in Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) due to approaching Tropical Storm Bolaven.

Effective Monday, October 9, 2023, Bank of Guam Headquarters, along with all Guam branches will close at 12:00 PM and their Familia Contact Center will close at 2:00 PM until further notice. CNMI branches will be closed on Monday.

In preparation for the storm, Bank of Guam encourages residents to:

- Withdraw cash
- Download our mobile banking app
- Secure your homes and clear loose items around your yard
- Have a flashlight and radio ready with fresh batteries
- Secure important documents and belongings on high ground
- Fill up your gas tanks
- Do your laundry

Bank of Guam will continue to monitor the situation and provide updates via its website and social media. In the meantime, customers are advised to stay informed about Tropical Storm Bolaven through official government channels, local news outlets, and weather advisories.
